# Greenhouse

- Growth and development
- Creating a fruitful and productive environment
- Focus on a natural way of learning, respecting differences between individuals
- Developing an **ecosystem** of knowledge, within each individual has a role and a natural balance is maintained.

**Core values:** Personal growth and development

**Concept (in one sentence):** The library as a nurturing environment to stimulate learning in a natural manner and the development of a knowledge ecosystem.

**Payoff:** Natural growth together

**Substantiation:**

The library transforms itself into a natural learning environment, where every individual's learning curve contributes to the greater whole of the library. It transcends its role as a knowledge institution to become a knowledge ecosystem. A balanced and self sustaining organic and dynamic collective where each learning curve is of equal importance and deserves individual focus.

By allowing people to grow and learn in an environment that feels natural to them, gaining knowledge becomes a more comfortable and motivating experience. The concept of an knowledge ecosystem places the individual development in a communal/societal context and allows people to connect with one another and shape their environment.

Within this concept balance is key and participation within the collective is essential to fully thrive and blossom. Whilst focussing on one's own development, the ecosystem requires a contribution to the development of others to maintain stability.

Community garden where people come together to study, share knowledge and contribute to the garden.

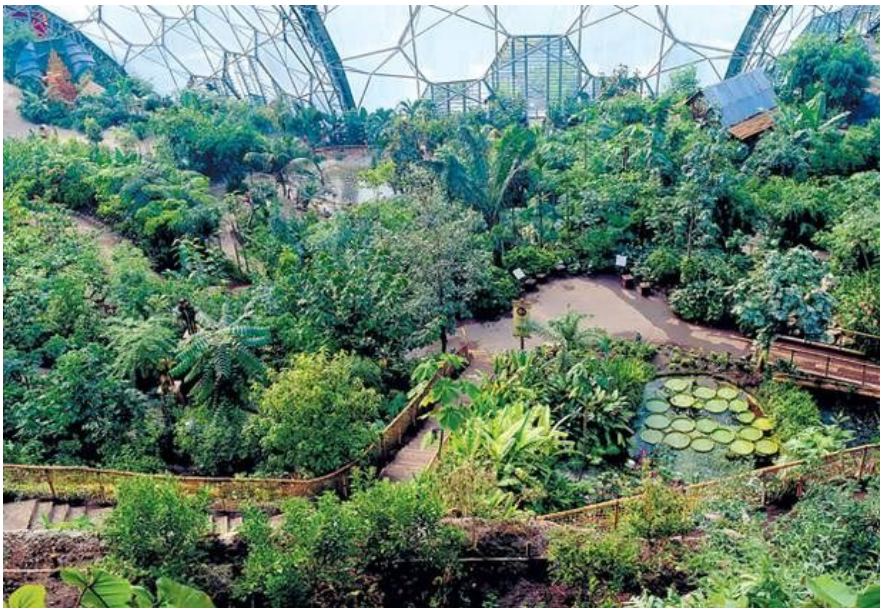
**Digital Idea**

Digital knowledge ecosystem. Monitor the diversity of the library, your personal growth/development and the growth of the library.

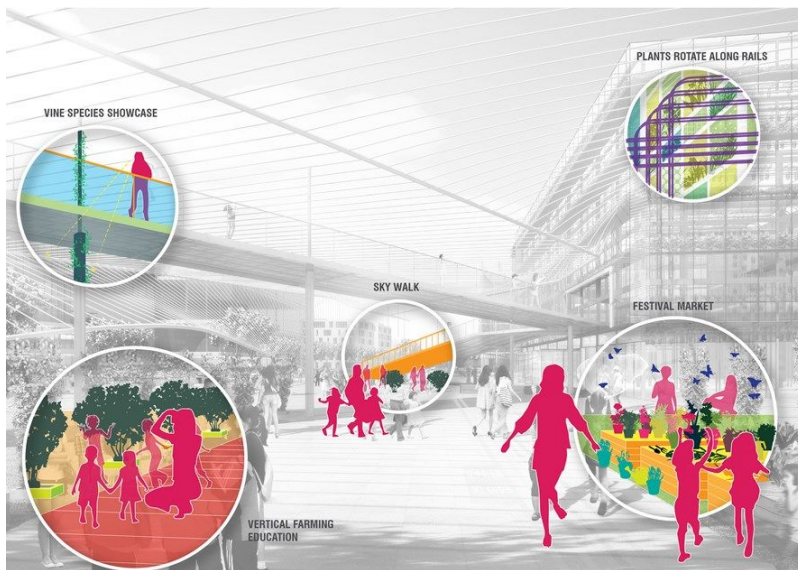
